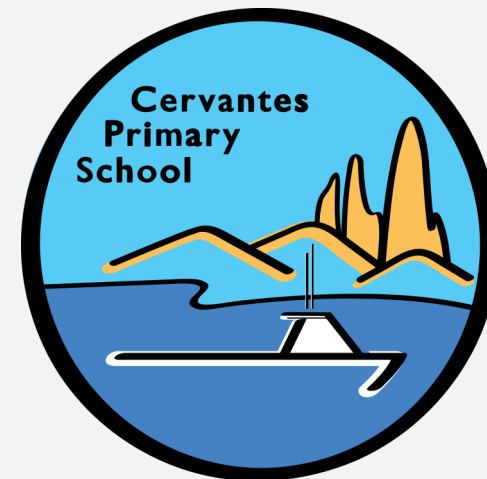
- focus on improving learning outcomes for ALL students;

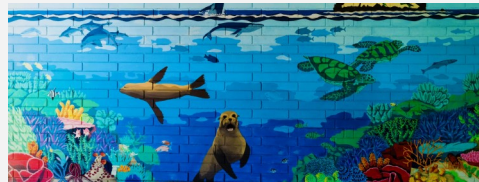


Board Role

Roles and Responsibilities

- The responsibilities of an Independent Public School Board are to:
- Work within the Department of Education's relevant legislation and regulations;
- Contribute to the School Delivery and Performance Agreement and the Business Plan;
- Endorse and review the annual budget;

- Assists with the formulation of codes of conduct;
- Reviews the performance of the school;
- Create interest in the school within and across the community;
- Assist with principal selection when a vacancy arises;
- Approve fees and charges, contributions and items of personal use (booklists);
- Approve arrangements for sponsorship and advertising;
- Liaise with other committees within the school;
- Hold one open meeting each year to report to the school community; and
- Provide advice to the principal on religious education and related activities.



Membership

Membership of the board includes parents, members of the community and staff of the school.

It is to consist of at least five people but no more than 15 and parents/community members must form the majority.

The principal will call for nominations to fill parent and staff vacancies on the board as they arise and conduct elections if necessary.

A member of the board shall hold office for a term not exceeding 3 years, but may be renominated more than once.
